All spaces are 10' X 10'. There will be a fee for vendors based on their booth and needs. Due to our unique mountain environment, the available spaces will be in various locations. Some spaces are near our historical cabins while others are in natural settings. Because of our unique environments, most spaces are not level, please come prepared to adapt to your space. The Southern Appalachian Historical Association, SAHA, is committed to preserving the aesthetic qualities of our location. As a result, we do not allow generators or other equipment which may cause noise or contribute to pollution. Deposits on these spaces are non-refundable, all fees and proceeds go to the education program of the Hickory Ridge Homestead.

\_\_\_ Please check if you have a canopy or cover. For the safety of you and our guest, the town fire marshal will be inspecting booths the morning of the Apple Festival. In accordance with laws, all tents, canopies or covers must be fire resistant, and have a labels attached. Booths using electricity or if flames are required, by law, to have a fire extinguisher greater than five pounds. Please note that if any of these requirements are not met, the fire marshal will require you to remove our tent and possibly your vending space.

Deposit fee is \$20.00 for all booths. Deposit plus application must be in the SAHA office by September 30, 2010. Deposits on these spaces are non-refundable, all fees and proceeds go to the education program of the Hickory Ridge Homestead. Final booth payment is due when you arrive to set up.
